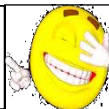


There was a plane crash, unfortunately every single person died! However two people survived, how is this possible? Did the spokesperson inform incorrectly?

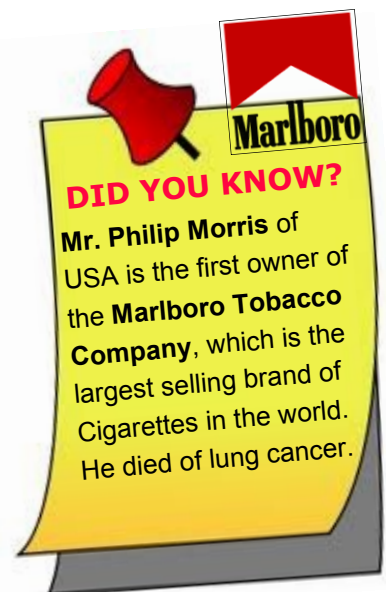
